THE CORRECT HOOF BOOTS FOR YOUR HORSE


WHAT DO I HAVE TO CONSIDER WHEN USING HOOF BOOTS?

- ✓ Measure hooves accurately before purchase
- \checkmark If necessary, get professional advice
- ✓ Regular hoof trimming and care by a specialist (approx. every 5-6 weeks)!
- \checkmark Before putting on the boot, make sure the hooves are clean and remove any stones from the inside of the boot.

HOW DO I MEASURE THE HOOVES OF MY HORSE?

- \checkmark Ideally measured directly on the picked up hoof
- \checkmark Best time approx. 1 week after hoof trimming
- ✓ Each hoof must be measured individually

MEASURE CORRECTLY



- **1.** Take measurements at the widest point of the hoof to determine the width.
- **2.** Measure the length of the hoof from the toe to the buttress line of the heel (please do not include the heel bulbs in the measurement).
- → If the measurements do not exactly match the size of the hoof boot, we recommend the next larger size.
- → If the width and length measurements are different by more than one size, this boot style is not recommended.
