

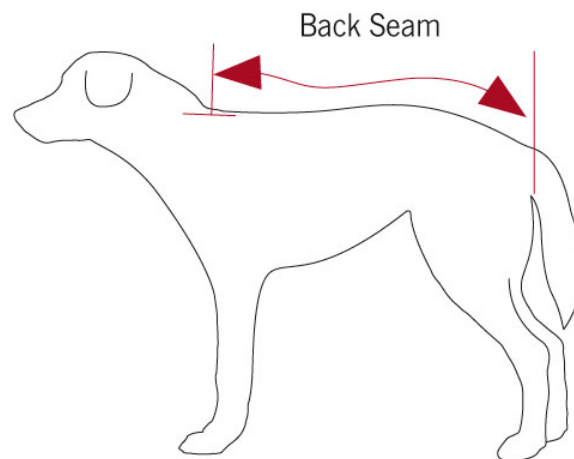
DOG COATS: HOW TO MEASURE YOUR DOG CORRECTLY

Your dog should feel completely comfortable in their dog coat. Therefore, the coat should neither be too tight nor too big/long, which could interfere with the dog's natural freedom of movement.

Remember: Dogs that have never worn a dog coat before need a short period of time to get used to it.

HOW IS A DOG MEASURED CORRECTLY?

- The dog should stand with its head upright in its natural position.
- The length of the back is measured from the base of the neck to the base of the tail.
- The tape measure is placed at the thickest part of the neck (between the shoulder blades), then is placed along the spine, down to the base of the tail.
- For dogs without a tail or with a tail carried high: measure to just before the base of the tail!
- Compare your measurements with the size chart of the respective dog coat: the coat should not deviate by more than a few centimetres from your measurements.



HOW DOES A DOG COAT FIT CORRECTLY?

- The dog coat completely covers the back
- The dog coat does not cut into the front and back legs.
- The front legs move freely within the front opening
- The coat can be fastened easily without pulling or pushing.
- The coat does not slip
- The dog is visibly comfortable and barely notices the dog coat.
